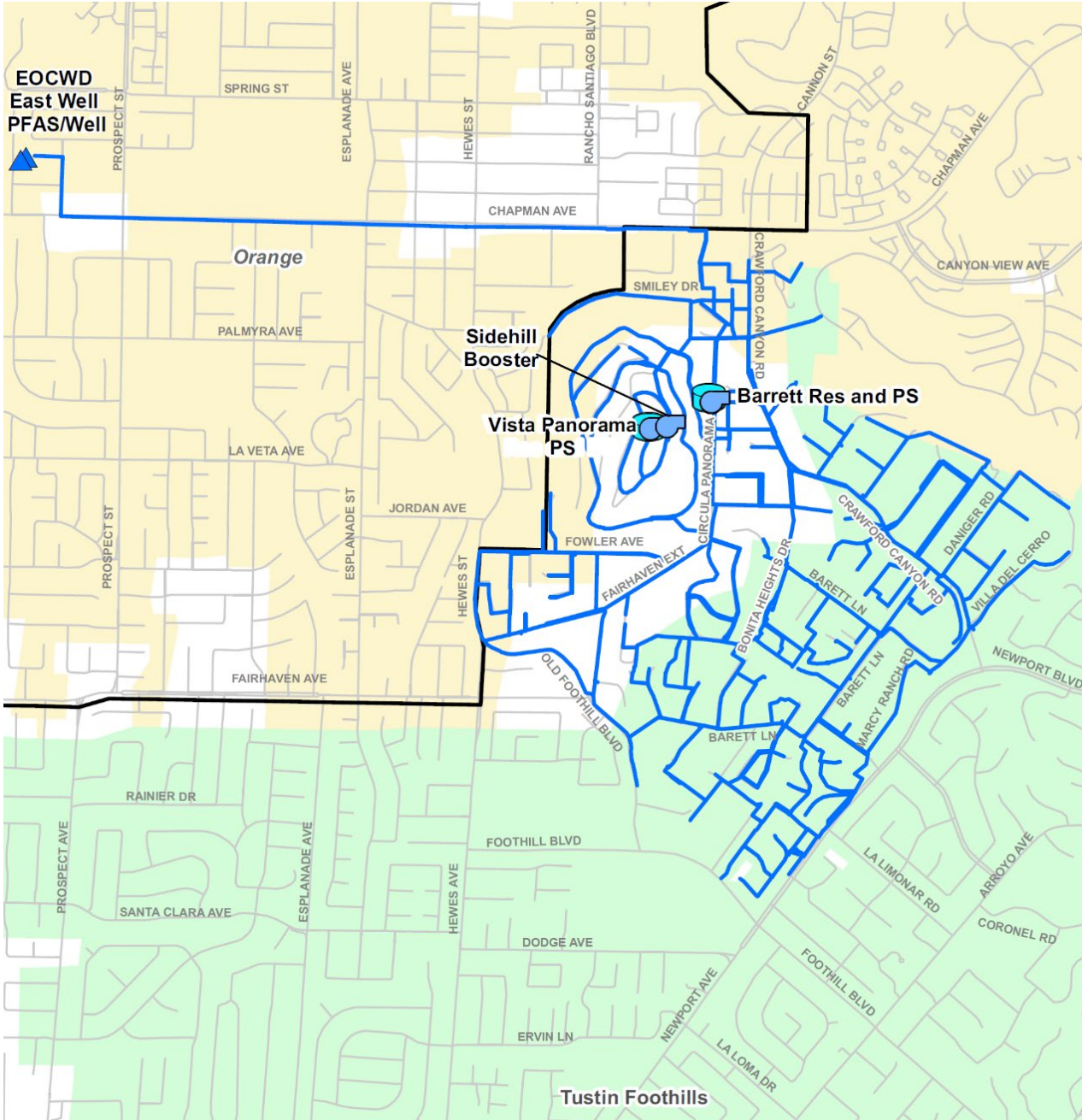
2. Please see attached map at the end of this Addendum for overall EOCWD retail site boundaries.

QUESTIONS and ANSWERS:

1. Question: *Can the Vista Panorama site be used as a base station or repeater site?*  
Answer: At this time, the Vista Panorama site should not be considered for any new construction.
2. Question: *Are the ¾" meters 7.5"?*  
Answer: EOCWD cannot confirm the exact measurement of all existing meter face-to-face dimensions. Proposers may assume standard lay lengths but should have considerations for field variations.

3. Question: *Can the proposal contain a hybrid solution of fixed network and cellular?*  
Answer: EOCWD will consider the proposals and any solutions presented for a turnkey AMI solution. Proposers are encouraged to provide their best solution considering the size of the water service area, topography, and total number of meters.
  
4. Question: *Will there be a short list for interviews?*  
Answer: A selection committee will review and rank all proposals. The top two firms may be invited for proposal presentation and an oral interview before the selection committee.
  
5. Question: *Are brass meters required, or will composite meters also be accepted?*  
Answer: All meter materials will be accepted, as long as they meet the applicable AWWA standard and are NSF 61 approved.
  
6. Question: *Since the proposals may be large, does the District have a file sharing website or location to upload the documents?*  
Answer: EOCWD does not have a secure file sharing site for receiving proposals. All large proposals should be sent by email to [byoung@eocwd.com](mailto:byoung@eocwd.com) with a link that allows EOCWD to download the contents. Proposers should confirm with EOCWD that files have been received and downloaded prior to the submission deadline.
